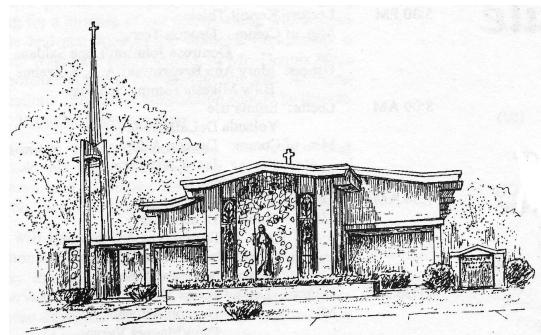

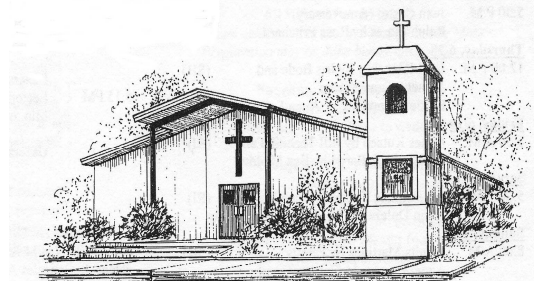
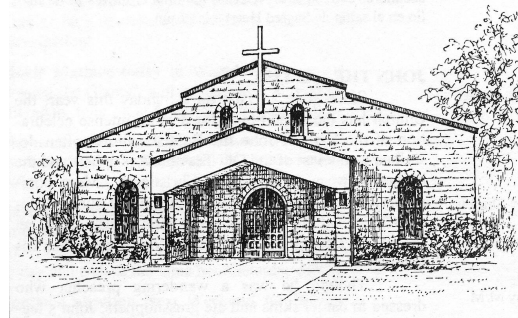

Blessing of Easter Baskets on Holy Saturday Morning

Traditionally, Catholics in Eastern Europe-Ukrainians, Russians, Czechs, Poles, and more- gather at their churches on Holy Saturday morning to bless baskets of food in thanksgiving for the end of Lent and arrival of Easter. This basket of blessed food is then eaten with the meal on Easter Sunday. Many Catholics in war torn areas have been forced from their homes or are living in dangerous regions where they are unable to gather. In solidarity with our Catholic brothers and sisters, we are inviting everyone in our community to bring your baskets and participate in this beautiful tradition on Holy Saturday morning, March 30th, at 9am in the St. James church.
